Photography

Book your photographer as soon as possible (Weekday and Sunday weddings may be discounted)

★

Always meet the photographer who will attend on the day. Check he is familiar with the ceremony and reception venue. Have they checked the positioning of the sun at the time of your wedding?

★

Ask to see a complete recent wedding album - not a "sample wedding album"

★

Go along discreetly to a wedding they are attending before yours

★

Decide the mixture of colour, black and white or sepia, formal, candid or natural

★

Give a written list of "must take" shots and the people you want in groups to your photographer and best man

★

Ask a family member to identify people on the day

★

A framed photo makes the perfect "thank you" present

★

Confirm all details in writing and get a receipt for the deposit (Check VAT, travel expenses and "additional location" expenses are included)
